


from 01/01/18 onwards some (old) cars are no longer allowed to enter Brussels due to the low emmission zone.



- E19 exit 12 Vilvoorde-Steenokkerzeel
- Drive in the direction of Steenokkerzeel
- On the 'big' cross road, turn right (on the Chaussée de Haecht)
- Vias institute is located on the right side at about 4-5 km

#### From the south side (Charleroi, Tournai...) or the east side (Liège...)

- RO exit 4 Diegem/Woluwelaan
- Turn left in the direction of Evere on the Chaussée de Haecht
- Vias institute is located on the right side at about 1.5 km

#### From the west side (Ostende, Bruges, Gand...)

- RO exit 5 Machelen
- Turn left Woluwelaan
- At the second cross road, turn left Chaussée de haecht
- Vias institute is located on the right side at about 1.5 km
